We would like to thank you for allowing us to host your golf league and look forward to seeing you in 2023!

The attached 2023 Registration Form, League Roster and League Fees for both league halves are due on or before March 1, 2023.

The 2022 bunker renovation is complete, and the bunkers look fantastic. Our focus in 2023 will be upgrading our maintenance facility and equipment so that we can continue to follow our long-term course improvement plan which includes all areas of the golf facility. The City of Dayton is committed to making upgrades to Community to give our golfers and patrons the best golf experience possible.

There have also been changes in our cart fees as well as our annual golf passes. I have included a 2023 rate sheet for you in this packet.

The 2023 league fees have not changed. Be sure to include your league fee (make checks payable to the City of Dayton) along with the registration form and player roster. We also accept cash and credit cards if paying in person.

We have been successfully using our Facebook page to communicate cart path rules, course conditions etc., so please let your golfers know to go to Facebook for up-to-date information.

Pre-season ProShop hours are 10:00am to 5:00pm weather permitting; if courses are closed the ProShop is open from 10:00am to 2:00pm. **If we do not receive your registration and payment for both halves before March 1st, you may lose your current league time.**

As league secretary, please submit an updated league roster to the GOLF SHOP prior to each half of the league season. Also, we ask that you relay the following important policies to your league participants:

- All golfers must comply with course staff while enforcing course policies.
- No more than 1 single rider cart per group, unless single rider cart fee has been purchased.
- If golfers wish to play 9 holes prior to league play, they must make a tee time.
- Receipts for play must be presented to starter **before each** round.
- Dress code (shirts must have sleeves)
- Ohio law does not allow for alcoholic beverages to be brought onto the course. All alcoholic beverages consumed on the premises (including the parking areas) must be purchased at the Restaurant.
- Pace of play is 2 hours 15 minutes for nine holes.
- Please remember to Rake Bunkers, Repair Ball Marks and Replace Divots
- All other rules and regulations set forth by the City of Dayton (available in pro-shop)
