The 2021 Registration Form, League Roster and League Fees for both league halves are due on or before March 1, 2021. If we do not receive your registration and payment for both halves before March 1, you may lose your current league time.

Construction is tentatively set to commence in the fall. Over the next two years, bunkers on nearly every hole will be renovated or redesigned! Due to the nature of the project, area's of the golf course may be closed once construction begins. We are committed to ensuring minimal impact on your league play prior to mid-September. Please plan accordingly as your league will have limited amount of time to make up for missed play without disruptions. To register your league for the 2021 season, please submit your league registration form, player roster and payment by March 1st. Pre-season ProShop hours are 10:00am to 5:00pm weather permitting; if courses are closed, the ProShop is open from 10:00am to 2:00pm Monday through Friday and closed on Weekends. Payment is accepted by phone, by mail or in-person. Please make checks payable to the City of Dayton.

As League Secretary, we ask that you review and relay the following important policies to your league participants. Please submit an updated league roster to the GOLF SHOP prior to each half of the league season.

- **NEW** - Masks are required when entering any golf facility: ProShop, Locker Rooms, Restrooms, Restaurant, etc. Follow all social distancing requirement. We appreciate your cooperation in helping to keep your friends and golf course safe.
- **NEW** - Golf Carts are equipped with a plastic divider. Single riders are charged a surcharge of \$5 for 9-holes and \$10 for 18-holes.
- **NEW** - Due to demand, the course is not hosting shotgun events/outings. League events must occur within your approved tee times.
- Receipts for play must be presented to starter before each round.
- Dress code (shirts must have sleeves).
- All alcoholic beverages consumed on the premises (including the parking areas) must be purchased at the Restaurant. Ohio law does not allow alcoholic beverages to be brought onto the course.
- Pace of play is 2 hours and 15 minutes for nine holes
- Please remember to Rake Bunkers, Repair Ball Marks and Replace Divots.
- All other rules and regulations set forth by the City of Dayton (available in pro-shop)
